#### **Abstract Submission:**

Anonymous abstracts written in English for 30-minute oral presentations should be submitted as email attachments in MS Word to Prof. Kyungchul Chang (Pusan National Univ.) at <a href="mailto:busan.abstract@gmail.com">busan.abstract@gmail.com</a> by February 29, 2016 with "ABSTRACT" stated as an email subject. The following information should also be provided in the body of the e-mail:

- The title of the abstract
- The author's or authors' first name(s), family name(s), affiliation(s)
- E-mail address and contact (mobile) phone number
- Preferable presentation area in the above five areas
- Preferable presentation date and time

The abstract should consist of 200-250 words (main body) and 4-6 keywords, and not exceed two A4 pages including references. The format is 12 point Times New Roman font, single-lined, margins set to 2.54 cm (1 inch) all around. Presenters will be notified by March 10, 2016.

## The Abridged Paper or Powerpoint (PPT) Slides Submission for Proceedings:

The at most 5-page abridged paper or ppt should be submitted by June 30, 2016. Further details for the submission will be notified in due course. Excellent papers presented in the conference will be recommended for submission to an international journal, *Journal of Language Sciences*, quarterly published by the KALS.
